## Safe Sitter Babysitting Class

Safe Sitter is a nationally recognized course designed to train youth who may be caring for younger siblings, neighbors or friends. During this 8-hour basic course, students learn the basics of caring for a young child, including Babysitting as a Business, Success on the Job, Child Care Essentials, Safety for the Sitter, Injury Management, Preventing Problem Behavior, Care of a Choking Infant, Care of a Choking Child, Preventing Injuries and Behavior Management. Separate courses will be offered for participants interested in becoming CPR and First Aid certified. Attendance is required for entire class session to be Safe Sitter Certified. Courses are held at the North Street facility. **Students need to bring pencil and paper, and a sack lunch including a drink.**
